Thank you for your interest in Radio Delaware Valley. Radio Delaware Valley is owned and operated by the Bux-Mont Educational Radio Association, a Non-profit Private Corporation. BMERA (Bux-Mont Educational Radio Association) operates Non-Commercial FM station WRDV-FM 89.3 Warminster and Translators 107.3 FM Philadelphia 97.1 FM Bensalem and Non-Commercial station WLBS-FM 91.7 Bristol Twp. The stations are operated entirely by volunteers, these are people from all walks of life, people who are interested in radio as a career and people who are in it for a hobby and the love of the music. We are always looking for volunteers who are interested in radio and the service we perform, and are willing to make a commitment of 2-5 hours per week to RDV.

Our format: Weekdays 8AM to 6PM – musicals sounds of the 30's 40's and early 50's big band and swing. This is a tight musical format with no deviation from the format.

Weeknights: 7PM till 1AM or later, are specialty programs featuring different musical sounds

IE: easy listening, traditional country, blues and soul and show tunes.

Weekends: solid gold oldies, the lesser known and played oldies.

Funding: Each on air person is charged a \$25.00 per month tuition activity fee. This fee covers operational costs of the station. Funding is also provided through grants and donations from local businesses and corporations. Listener support is also requested during our annual fund drives. Staff members are encouraged to obtain sponsorships for the station and in turn are credited tuition activity fees while sponsored.

Upon becoming a staff member, RDV-FM will provide the training and the opportunity for you to produce your own radio show and operate the station.

As with any organization, we have rules and regulations along with FCC regulations governing the operation of a FM station, which all staff members must follow.

When you begin your training sessions you will purchase a training manual which contains informational hand out sheets covering the operation of the station, rules of the station, the organization and rules of conduct.

We hope you will find the world of radio broadcasting interesting and we look forward to working with you as you embark on the new and exciting world of radio.
